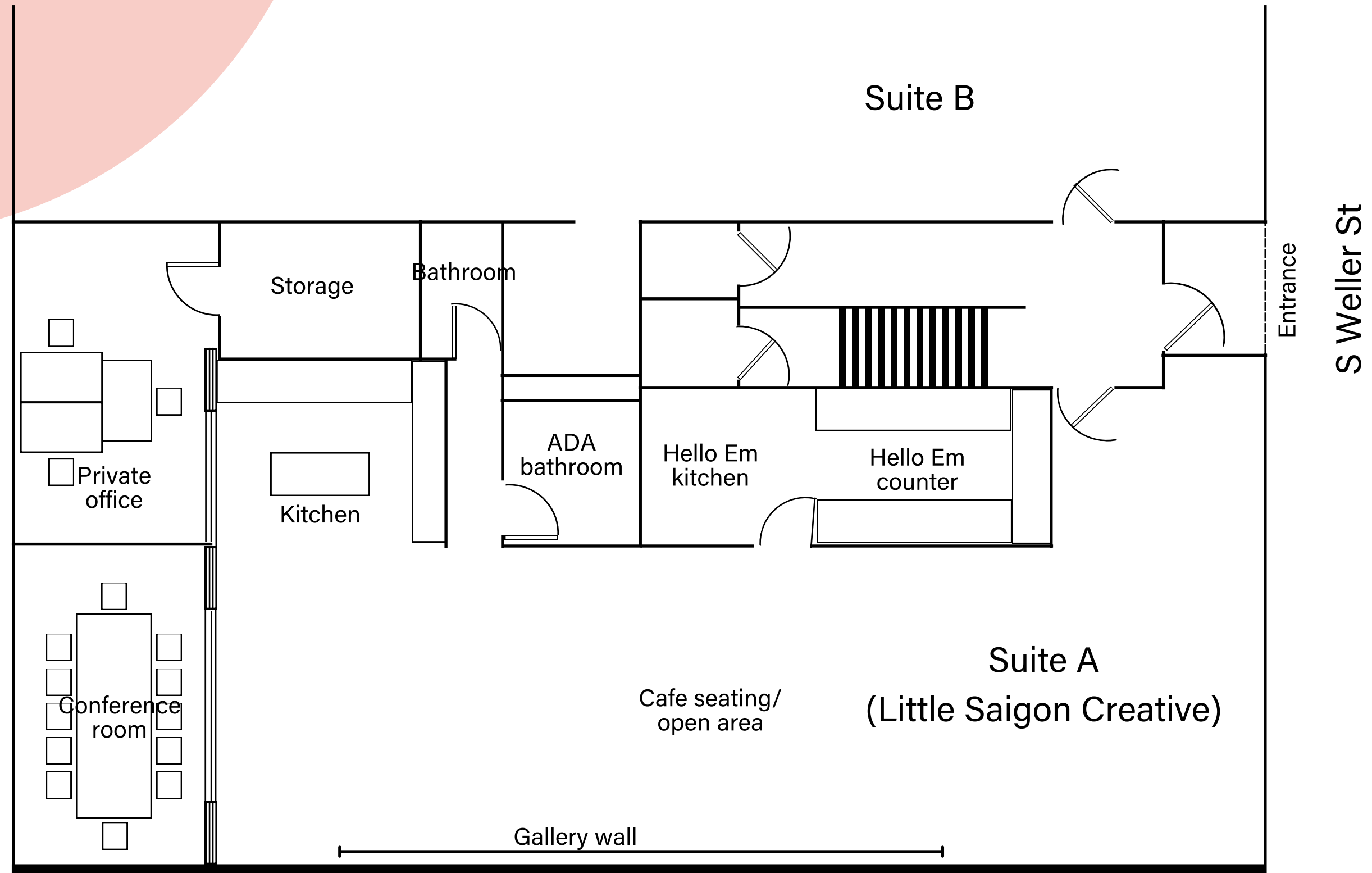

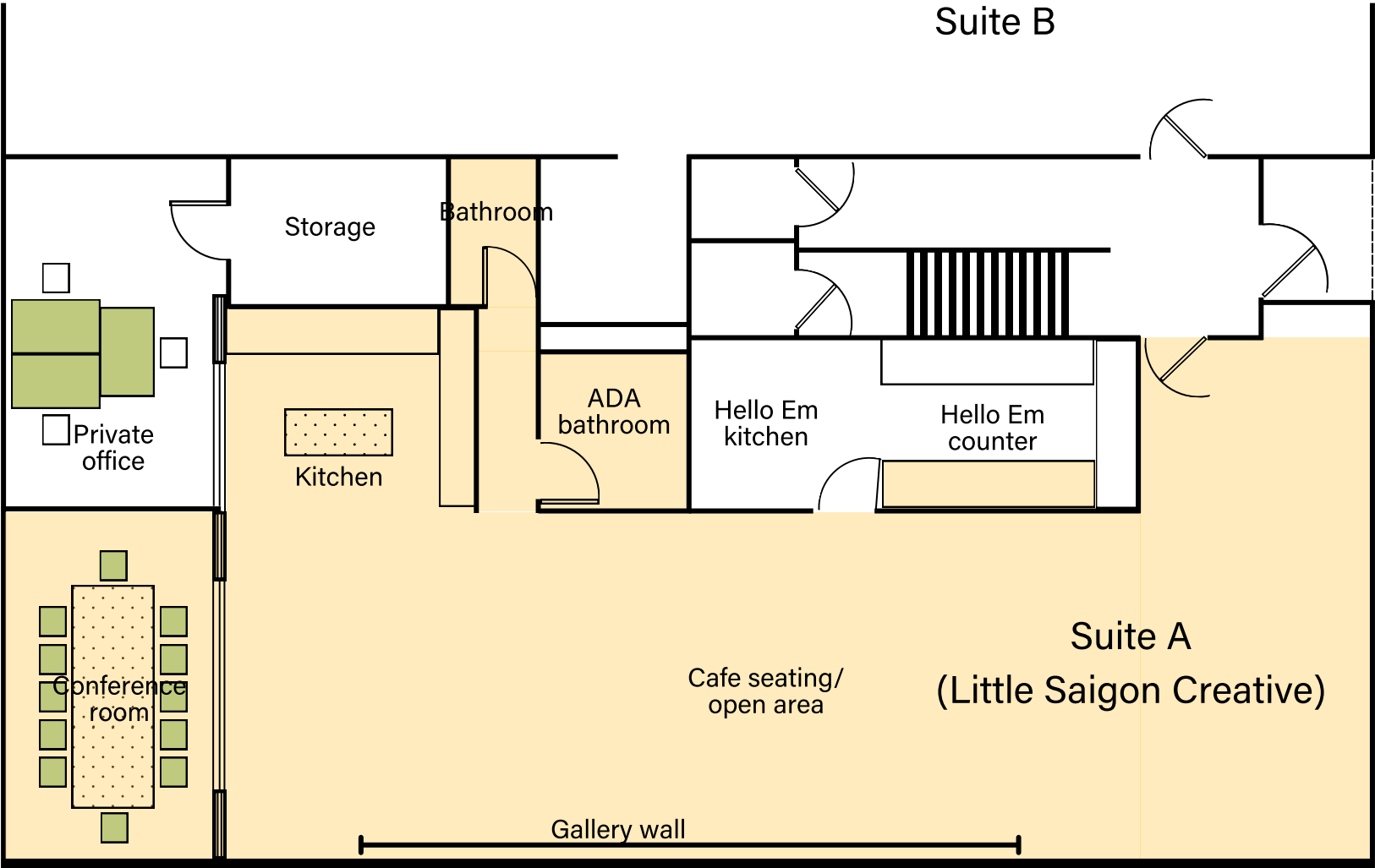

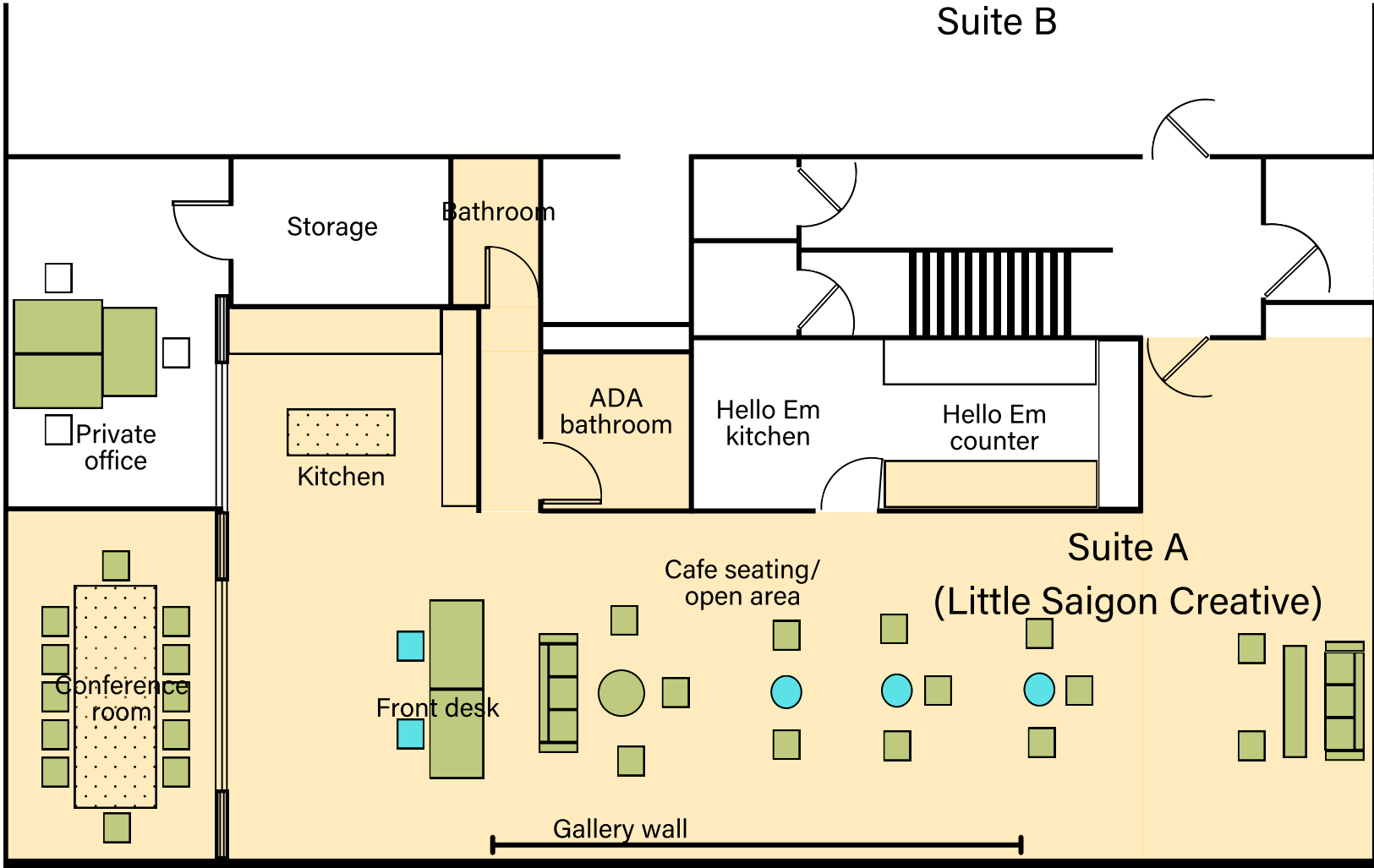
Floor Plan:
